

## COMMUNITY COLLEGE TIMELINE for Class of 2018

Date	Action
October 1, 2017 – March 2, 2018	<b>FINANCIAL AID (FAFSA)</b> The priority time period to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is October 1, 2017 – March 2, 2018.
January 2018	<b>Sign up in Career Center</b> in January for the February Community College Application Workshops (space is limited and will fill up).
February 1, 2018	<b>APPLICATION</b> Applications for the Los Rios Community College District (Cosumnes River College, Sacramento City College, American River College and Folsom Lake College) will open on February 1, 2018. Students can complete the online application on their own, or they can participate in an Application Workshop at CO in mid-February.
Once ID# is received	<b>eSERVICES</b> After a student completes the online application they will receive their Los Rios Student ID# in an email. Once student has an ID# it is important they set up their eServices account on the college website.
February – March 2018	<b>ORIENTATION</b> The Los Rios Orientation is online. Students may complete it on their own, or sign up for an Orientation Workshop which will be offered at CO in late February or early March.
February – March 2018	<b>ASSESSMENTS</b> <u>All</u> community college freshmen <u>must</u> take Math and English Assessments. Exam results determine Math and English course placement. These exams may only be taken once. <u>Students are encouraged to study before taking the Math assessment.</u> The assessments are taken on the college campus.
March 2018	<b>COLLEGE COUNSELOR MEETING</b> Once the student has completed the Online Orientation, and the Math and English assessments, they must make an appointment with the college counseling office for a New Student Counseling Session. If student meets with a counselor <u>before April 1, 2018</u> they will receive a higher priority registration date. Note: There may be a CRC New Student Counseling Session held at COHS. Information will be available in February.
April 2018	<b>FINANCIAL AID (BOG)</b> The Application for the Board of Governor's Fee Waiver will become available on the college websites in early April. Students who qualify will have their tuition (cost of classes only) waived.
May 2018	<b>REGISTRATION</b> The date and time when course registration will open for each student will be posted in their eServices. The student may register for Summer 2018 and/or Fall 2018 at any time after the posted date and time.
Immediately Following Course Registration	<b>FEES</b> Fees are due upon registering for courses. Students will be dropped from courses if they have not paid all fees within 14 days of registering.
