Youth & Government Day Field Trip

Students from COHS had the opportunity to participate in the City of Elk Grove's first Youth & Government Day. Students met with city leaders, including the mayor, city manager, chief of police, and a city council member. The City of Elk Grove's Human Resources Department walked students through a resume workshop where they were about to fine tune their resumes they created from their Focus on College & Career class. Students were paired up with a city employee to tour city hall and practice interview skills, participated in a recycling jeopardy game, and were able to walk through the police department's forensics and dispatch unit, and meet an officer & her K-9 dog, Gunner.



Leadership Summit 2021

In July of 2021, Coach Roth will be taking a group of students to Germany to compete in an international competition at the EF Leadership Summit in Berlin, Germany. But before we arrive in Berlin we will make stops in Lisbon and Porto, Portugal, where we will explore Porto's global trading port, its supply chains, and the natural resources involved. We will discover the role the ocean has played in Portuguese history and traditions, and explore sustainability efforts aimed towards preserving under-water ecosystems.

From Portugal we will continue on to Berlin where we will focus on *Creating a Sustainable Future* with other students and teachers from around the globe. Students will hear from world-renowned keynote speakers, work with local and global experts, and collaborate with peers in small international teams. Using the Design-Thinking process created by Stanford University, teams will develop solutions focused on *Creating a Sustainable Future*.
