Spirit Week:

Our Annual Homecoming Spirit Week begins Monday September 25. Each day students dress according to the daily theme. All outfits must conform to the district dress code.

The dress up days are as follows:

Monday – Music Monday: Dress up as your favorite artist, wear your favorite band’s merchandise, or dress up as the instrument you play, and if you are in the CO Band feel free your wear your band attire!

Tuesday – Tie-dye Tuesday: Wear any and all tie-dye that you own! (We have CO tie-dye spirit wear in the student store if you need to get some!)

Wednesday – CHAD Day: Crazy Hair And Dress day. Yes. It’s back.

Thursday – Tropical Thursday: Dress for a day at the beach, tacky tourist, or tropical getaway. This like you are going on a trip to the US Virgin Islands.

Friday – Float Friday: Dress according to your class float theme:

- Freshmen – Back to the Future (mad scientists, 50s or 80s clothes)
- Sophomores – Grease!
- Juniors – The Wizard of OZ
- Seniors – Jaws (lifeguard, scuba diver, swimmer, summer day)

Homecoming Parade & Game:

Friday September 29 is the Homecoming Parade and Game Day. All students can view the Homecoming Parade from the campus quad. The parade will begin at 2:29 pm and conclude around 3:13. Students are dismissed from class early to view the parade. Parents interested in viewing the parade should do so in front of the PAC next to the flagpole or in the student pickup area in front of the MP Room.

The normal pickup lane in front of the MP room will be closed until the conclusion of the parade. Wolfpack Lane will be closed southbound between the PAC and the library parking lot from 2:00 until the end of the parade.

The Homecoming Game is against Roseville High School. Go Wolfpack! The varsity game will be held at Cosumnes Oaks starting at 7:15 pm. Admission to the game is \$5 for students with ID and free for students with an ASB Card. ASB Stickers/Cards are \$40 (they go up to \$50 on October 1) and provide students with tremendous discounts on dances, theater performances and athletic events. Parent and guest tickets are \$7 each. During halftime, the winning float will be announced as well as the winners of the spirit week. Finally, the Royalty Court will be presented and the Homecoming King & Queen will be crowned.

Homecoming Dance:

The dance is the night of September 30. The dance is \$15 w/ASB and \$20 w/out ASB. Guest tickets (with an approved pass) are \$20 w/ASB and \$30 without ASB. The last chance to purchase tickets for the dance is Friday September 29 during both lunches. No tickets will be sold after school due to the parade. Tickets can be purchased immediately; don't be left out because the lines get too long at lunch!!

Guest pass applications may be downloaded from the COHS Website under "Students" and then select "ASB", and are also attached to this message. Guest passes must be submitted to the Vice Principal's office by Friday September 22. Students must have a current ID card for admission to the dance. NO EXCEPTIONS! There are no "temporary" IDs sold at the dance and no refunds given for those without IDs. Guests must bring a Photo ID to the dance and must enter the dance with their student host. Guests arriving before or after their host will be turned away. Coat check will be provided at the dance in the Auxiliary Gym.

Please remember:

- The dance is from 7:00pm – 10:00 pm.
- You must have your school ID card to gain entrance to the dance. Your ID card is the only thing that validates a ticket has been purchased.
- No ID Card = No Entrance to the dance.
- No students will be admitted after 8:00pm. Students may not leave before 9:00 pm. Students MUST be picked up no later than 10:30pm or they will not be allowed to attend future dances or other ASB activities.
- Students may attend solo. You do not have to have a date. Even better, go with a group of friends.
- This dance is semi-formal. To be admitted:
 - Men must be in slacks and a collared shirt. No shorts, jeans/denim, t-shirts, or torn clothing.
 - Women must be in a dress or pant suit. Dresses must be fingertip length and may not be strapless (one shoulder strap is OK). Garments may not have cutouts or violate any dress code items addressed in the Student Handbook. No shorts, jeans/denim, t-shirts, or torn clothing.
- Inappropriate dancing (dirty dancing) is not allowed. Students who are caught with inappropriate dancing will be removed from the dance and not allowed to attend further dances this year.
- Any student who interferes with the actions of administration or staff in the performance of their duties will be exited from the dance and may not be permitted to attend any future dances. An example of this would be the use of whistles or other methods of distracting administration or staff.
- This dance is part of the Senior Package.

Senior Package

This is also the last week to purchase the senior package.

They are \$630 and can be purchased at the student store during both lunches, or if you wish to use your credit card you may go online at https://webstores.activenetwork.com/school-software/cosumnes_oaks_high_s/. Online, you may only buy the package; all al-a-carte items must be purchased at the student store. (The two package choices online include one with an ASB card or one without. You must purchase the option that includes the ASB card unless the student already has one.)

If you purchase the Great America or Disneyland trips, you must complete the permission slip(s) in the attached packet and turn them in when the trip is purchased. Both Great America and Disneyland have a maximum of 350 students and usually sell out, so make sure you don't wait until the end to secure your seat.

The last day to buy tickets is (if space is still available):

- Great America—Nov 1
- Disneyland—Apr 5
- Senior Ball—Apr 13
- All other tickets can be purchased starting now until three days before the event.

Great America includes transportation, ticket to Winterfest, and a \$20 food card. We leave on December 1 at 1:30 pm and return about 1:00 am.

Disneyland includes transportation, snacks on the way down, and a ticket to both parks. We leave at 4:30 am on May 5, and return about 9:30 am the following day.

Please note: No changes may be made to package. If your student already has an ASB card, that cost will be deducted from the package price. No other adjustments may be made.
