## November

- SAT
- Submit CSU or UC Applications NO later than November 30th. There are no late applications accepted.
- Search for Scholarships online, in the Career Center and in the community

## December

- SAT/ACT still accepted by some UC and CSU
- Search for Scholarships
- EG Regional Scholarships available online
- Request Letter of Recs for scholarships

## January

- Send SAT/ACT scores to colleges
- Complete EG Regional Scholarship Foundation Application - they are due this month

## February

- Search for scholarships

## March

- March 2nd **CAL GRANT DEADLINE**
- UC/ CSU Admissions acceptance letters received by students March through May
- Take UC Analytical Placement Exam in May

### **PRIVATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES**

- Various application deadlines. Check college websites for admission dates. Some open as early as July and some stay open until the following July.
- Create a Common Application account. You **MUST** put your counselor's email address in as your **"RECOMMENDER."**
- Request Letters of Recommendation in **SEPTEMBER**. You will need your counselor's and teacher's e-mail addresses.
- Contact an Admissions Representative from the colleges you would like to attend for additional information.

**SAT Information**

SAT Exam—No Writing: \$49.50  
SAT Exam—With Writing: \$64.50

SAT Subject Tests: \$26 for the first test; \$22 for each additional test

**Please note:** The writing section is required by the UC's and many private colleges but **is not** required by CSU's.
