November

- SAT

- SAT/ACT still accepted by most UC and CSU
- Search for Scholarships
- EG Community Foundation scholarships available in Career Center
- Request Letter of Recs for scholarships

January

- Send SAT/ACT scores to colleges
- Complete EG Community Foundation Scholarship applications due January

February

- Community College applications

March

- March 2nd **Cal Grant deadline**
- Take Community College Placement Test
- UC/ CSU Admissions acceptance letters received by students.
- Take UC Analytical Placement Exam in May

***PRIVATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES**

- Various application deadlines. Check college websites for admission deadlines.
- Create a Common Application account.
- Request Letters of Recommendation in **SEPTEMBER**. (You will need your counselor's and teacher's e-mail addresses.)
- Contact an Admissions Representative from the colleges you would like to attend for additional information.

SAT Information

SAT Exam (no Writing): \$46
SAT Exam with Writing: \$60
SAT Subject Tests: \$26 for the first test; \$21 for each additional test

Please note: the writing section is required by the UC's and many private colleges, and **is not** required by CSU's.

Fee Waivers are available based on demonstrated financial need.

ACT Information

The ACT test fee is \$46.00 (no writing) and \$62.50 (Plus Writing).

Students may register for one of two test options: the ACT or ACT Plus Writing which includes a 30-minute Writing Test.

Check the ACT website for a list of institutions that **recommend or require** the results from the ACT Writing Test.

Fee Waivers are available based on demonstrated financial need.
