IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Thank you for being interested in the WOLFPACK SOCCER PROGRAM for the winter of 2017-2018. In the last 4 years, we have proven to be the best high school soccer program in Elk Grove. We have won 3 league titles and 3 section championships. We are not done yet. We will continue being successful and that's why we need to work together to accomplish that. The bar has been set really high and we want players to play to these high expectations.

COMMITMENT, DISCIPLINE, HARD WORK and TALENT are the qualities we are looking for in those who are interested in being part of the program for the next season.

We are not looking only for talented players but also for students-athletes who want to commit to be a role model in all areas at school, students athletes who want to be RESPECTFUL, HONORABLE, ENGAGE AND RESPONSIBLE.

Students from all levels are welcome to try out for our program (JV and Varsity) if they LOVE THE SCHOOL, HAVE A PASSION FOR SOCCER and will put the TEAM FIRST.

Players will make either team based on their TALENT, ATHLETIC and PHYSICAL ABILITY, MENTAL TOUGHNESS, KNOWLEDGE of the game and EXPERIENCE.

Most of our players play CLUB SOCCER at the highest level all year round but this doesn't mean you will make the team automatically. We will do our selection based on what the players show during tryouts and not on what they have done in their club.

So, if you think you have what it takes to be part of the COHS SOCCER PROGRAM, these are important dates and information you need to consider:

- In order to tryout you have to complete the Athletic Clearance Process that includes the SPORTS PHYSICAL FORM, THE COHS ATHLETIC PERMISSION SLIP, THE AGREEMENT FOR TEAM PARTICIPATION, THE STUDENT ALTERNATE TRANSPORTATION FORM, THE CONCUSSION AND HEAD INJURY INFORMATION SHEET, THE EGUSD EMERGENCY INFORMATION FORM, THE VOLUNTARY ATHLETIC CONTRIBUTION FORM,
- Student athletes must have a 2.00 GPA or better from FIRST TERM report card, 2017-2018 school year.
- You can pick up Clearance Packets in the front office before and after school.
- There will be a WINTER Athletic Clearance Night on NOVEMBER 1st and 2nd from 4 pm to 7:00 pm in the STUDENTS ACTIVITIES ROOM HC-6. Parents will bring the information above to clear the student to play sports in the winter. Players **don't have** to be present in order to be cleared. Please remember that all physicals must be dated on/after **May 1st, 2017** to be valid for the 2017-2018 school year. - TRYOUT:** will be from Monday, November 6th to Friday, November 10th Time and location to be determined. Please, bring shin guards water and a white and color shirt. Also remember that you won't be allowed to try out without the clearance card you will receive when you turn in all the paper work. Students who show up to tryouts are expected to be in EXCELLENT PHYSICAL SHAPE.
- There won't be soccer conditioning this WINTER. You are expected to be in shape.

- GAME DAYS:** our games will be played on TUESDAYS and FRIDAYS mostly, last game will be played on THURSDAY
 - AWAY games JV plays at 3:30 pm and Varsity at 5:30 pm
 - HOME games JV plays at 3:30 pm and Varsity at 5:30 pm.
 - Games at Bella Vista will be Varsity at 3 pm and JV to follow.
- TRANSPORTATION**
 - Dismissal time for away games will be at 1:15 pm, bus will be leaving at 1:30 pm.
 - Dismissal time for Bella Vista game will be at 1:00 pm and bus will be leaving at 1:15 pm.
- PRACTICE SCHEDULE**
 - Time and location to be determined.
 - JV will practice at grass field and Varsity at the stadium unless a change is communicated by the coach.
