<p>November 15</p>	<p><u>Elks National Foundation – Most Valuable Student</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Elks National Foundation will award <u>500 four-year scholarships</u> • Male and female students compete separately. • Scholarships range from \$1,000 – \$12,500 per year for up to four years <p>Applicants must meet all of the following criteria to be eligible for this scholarship:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must be a current high school senior. • You must be a citizen of the United States on the date your application is submitted; permanent legal resident status does not qualify. • You must take either the ACT or SAT on or before October 27, 2018. <p>NOTE: Applicants do <u>not</u> have to be the dependent of an Elks member to apply.</p> <p>The 20 top finalists will participate in an all-expenses paid <u>Leadership Weekend</u> in Chicago during which they'll interview with the national judges.
